COACHES/UMPIRE MEETING

Each club was represented at a very productive meeting with me at the Hermit Park clubrooms before the first game of the season. Spirit of the laws, other interpretations, send off law, and abusive language. Coaches were then asked to make suggestions or comment on issues they would like addressed. As a result of this meeting coaches are not writing appraisals on umpires making constructive criticism and helpful comments to improve communication links between players and the man in white.

INTERPRETATIONS OF THE LAWS

ORDER OFF LAW: A player who is reported by an umpire for a breach of the laws of the game, twice in the same match, or who is reported for serious breach, shall be ordered from the ground for the remainder of the match. He may be replaced. Undue interference with, or threatening language towards an umpire, assault, kicking and misconduct, shall be regarded as serious breaches. If a player refuses to leave the ground he shall be reported and his team shall forfeit the match.

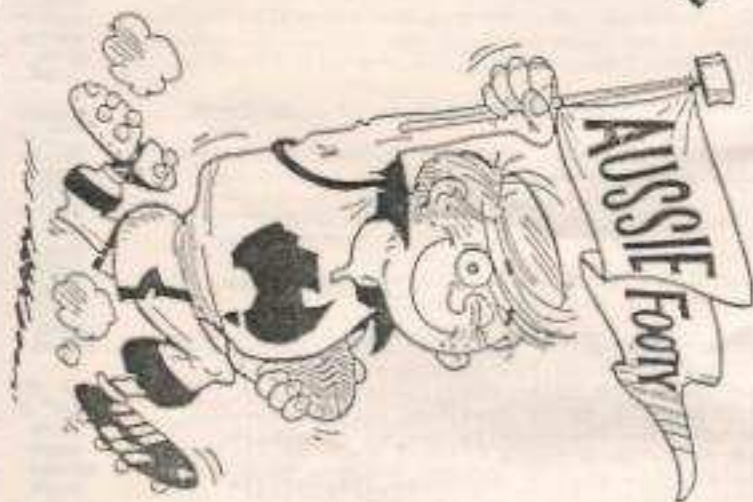

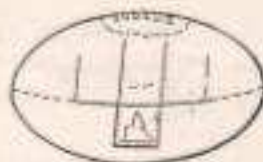
